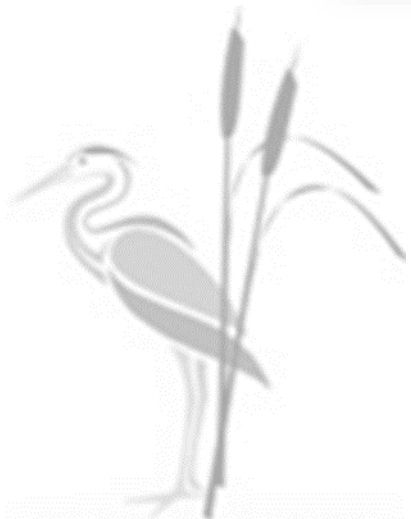

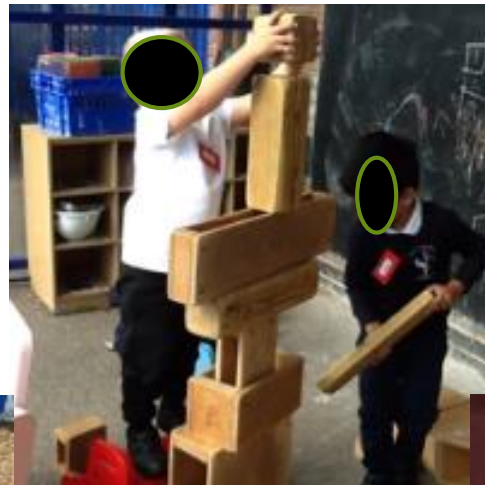
Why do we invite you into Nursery for a visit?

Everything your child learns at Nursery will be through carefully planned play activities.



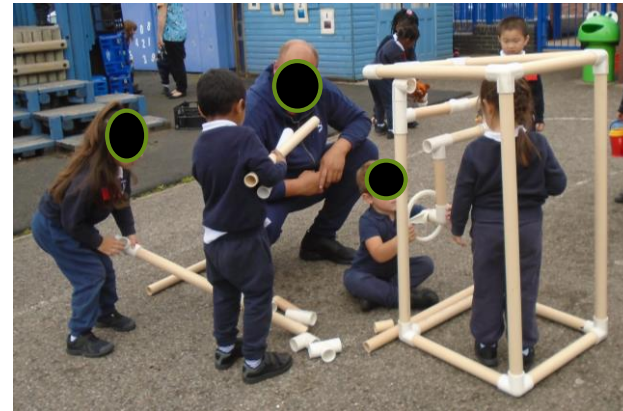
Outdoor Play

We look forward to getting to know you and your family and hope you will enjoy joining in with all the nursery has to offer over the year!

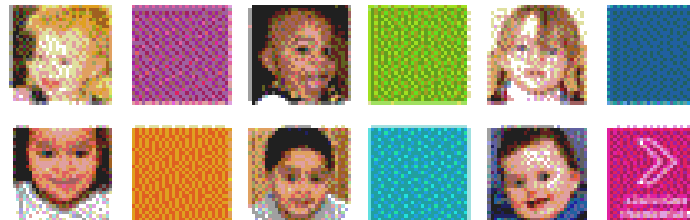

Children develop confidence, learn respect for others and gain social skills through activities like role play, circle time, singing and snack time.



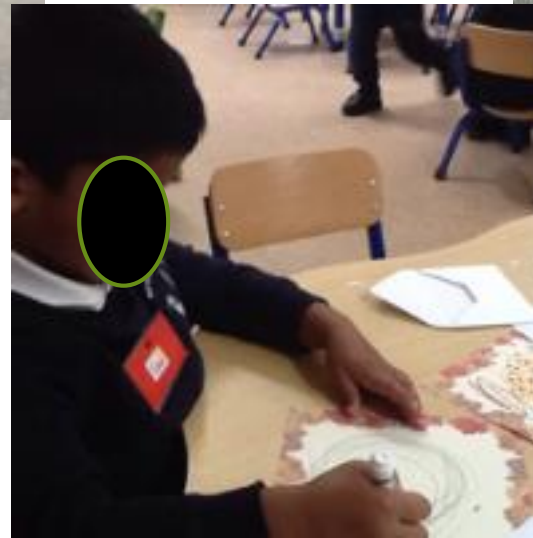
Communication and Language

We provide equipment and resources which are physically challenging both inside and outside.



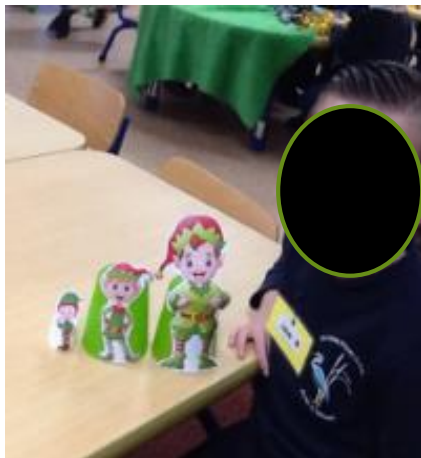
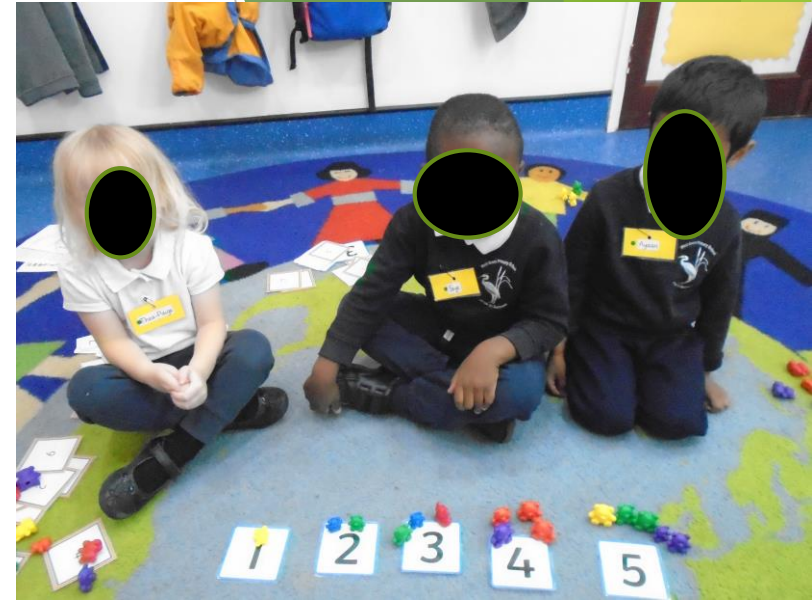
Literacy: Reading and Writing

Understanding the World

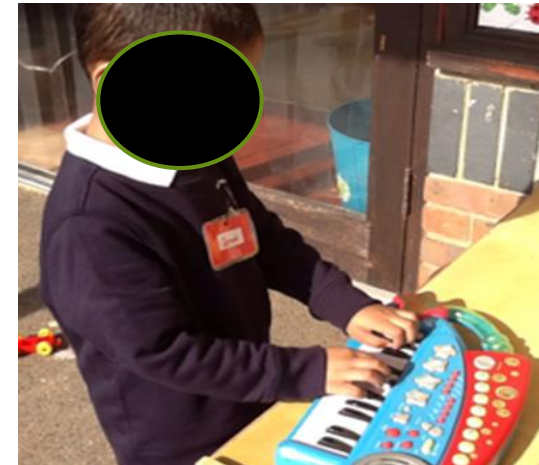
We encourage children to explore, experiment and observe so that they can gain knowledge to make sense of the world.

Morning start/end of session procedures

- ▶ Staff will open the nursery doors at 8.30am and close at 8.45am.
- ▶ Buggies/scooters **are not allowed** through the nursery doors, for safety reasons.
- ▶ Older siblings must wait outside the Nursery with a member of the Nursery staff
- ▶ Parents/carers come inside and encourage their child to find their name badge before settling their children into class. You are free to speak to the teacher or keyworkers at this time.
- ▶ At 11.30am, the end of the nursery session, parents come to the inside nursery door and a member of the Nursery team will call your child. The children must wait for their name to be called before they can go to the person collecting them, so that we can be sure they go home with the right person.
- ▶ Children will be collected by parents/carers from the same doors as morning drop off.
- ▶ If someone else is collecting your child please let staff or office know.
- ▶ If parents/carers are later than 11.35am children will be taken to the school office.

Afternoon start/end of session procedures

- ▶ Staff will open the nursery doors at 12.30am and close at 12.40pm.
- ▶ Buggies/scooters **are not allowed** through the nursery doors, for safety reasons.
- ▶ Older siblings must wait outside the Nursery with a member of the Nursery staff.
- ▶ Parents/carers come inside and encourage their child to find their name badge before settling their children into class. You are free to speak to the teacher or keyworkers at this time.
- ▶ At the end of the nursery session, parents come to the inside nursery door and a member of the Nursery team will call your child. The children must wait for their name to be called before they can go to the person collecting them, so that we can be sure they go home with the right person.
- ▶ Children will be collected by parents/carers from the same doors as afternoon drop off. Children may be collected between 3.15pm and 3.30pm.
- ▶ If someone else is collecting your child please let staff or the office know.
- ▶ If parents/carers are later than 3.35pm children will be taken to the school office.
