Subject specific vocabulary for the Spring Term




Here is a list of all the subject specific words you will come across in your lessons, along with a pictorial representation and their definition. You will come across these words over the course of the Spring term.





Spring Vocabulary - Pirates and the world around us		
Vocabulary	Picture	Definition and synonyms
pirate		A person who robs ships at sea and steals treasure.
(pirate) ship		Ships operated by pirates.
treasure (treasure chest)		A collection of precious metals, gems, or other valuable objects in a box or chest.

treasure map		A map that marks the location of buried treasure.
atlas		Maps of Earth or of a region of Earth.
sea/ocean		A huge body of saltwater that covers about 71 percent of Earth's surface.
island		An island is a body of land surrounded by water.

desert		Dry land with few plants and little rainfall.
forest		A large area filled with many trees.
rainforest		An often tropical woodland with a high annual rainfall.
jungle		Thick tropical forests.
polar desert		Polar deserts are the regions of Earth that fall under an ice cap climate.

hot / cold climate		Climate is the long-term pattern of weather in a particular area.
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Spring Vocabulary- Seasons		
Vocabulary	Picture	Definition and synonyms
winter		The coldest season of the year. Frosty, icy, cold.
spring		The season after winter and before summer. Warm, sunny, cloudy, sunshine, rain.
summer		The warmest season of the year. Sunshine, hot, holiday.

autumn		<p>The season after summer and before winter.</p> <p>Storm, chilly, rain.</p>
hailstone		<p>A small, hard ball of ice that falls from the sky like rain.</p>
thunder		<p>A loud rumbling or crashing noise.</p>
lightning		<p>Lightning is a bright flash of electricity produced by a thunderstorm.</p>
